- A Transformed Passover Meal
- The 7 Feasts Are Memory Aids & Rehearsals

The Last Supper

- The Passover Process and a Crucified Lamb
- Unleavened Bread “Get Out of Town”
- Exo 12 “Clean the House” 1 Cor 11:28

The Passover Meal

- Lamb Shank, Bitter Herbs, Salty Water, Charoset, Egg, Matzo
- Sequence of 4 Cups
- Kids Questions

The First Cup

- Hand Washing & Symbolic Cleansing
- Tasting & Rehearsing the Bitterness of Egypt

The Second Cup

- The Story and the Main Meal
- The Beauty of Jesus and Judas

The Third Cup “Redemption”

- A New Meaning to the Passover
- No Longer Egypt but the Cross

- Miracle or Symbol ? Jn 6:63

The New Covenant

- The Old: the Law, The New: the Finished Work
- Jn 19:30 It is Finished “Tetelestai”
- Jesus Traded Cups v36, Isa 53:6, Heb 10:10

You Are Not Finished

- Cause and Effect: Faith in Jesus Produces a Changed Life
- Salvation Spectators, Saved By Faith

The Fourth Cup “Restoration and Promise”

- Jesus Saves It For the Kingdom

The Promise “ See you next year in Jerusalem”

- 1 Cor 11:26 Proclaiming the Lord’s death until He comes
- The Wedding Supper Cup
