### **An Epic Embarrassing Crash**

- Noah, Moses, Abraham

### **Peter’s Crash Recorded in All Four Gospels**

- To Remind Us of Our Sin Nature
- To Warn Us of the Steps to Denial
- To Give Us Hope

### **#1 Trusting in Your Own Strength**

- Peter Was Loud and Had Some Power

### **A Dangerous Trust**

- Comparing Himself with Others
- Making Promises
- Arguing with Jesus (and the Bible)

### **Tonight You’ll Crash     Rom 12:3**

- An Unguarded Strength is a Double Weakness

### **#2 Sleeping Instead of Praying**

- V41 If Don’t Watch and Pray.... You Will Fall
- Lk 18:1 Pray and Not Faint
