- Last Book of the Bible: Resolves and Completes

Three Main Interpretations of Revelation

- Symbolic and Allegory
- Historical and Past- Preterist
- Literal and Future

Revelation : Apocalypse, Unveiling Jesus Christ

- The Son, Shepherd, Lamb, Judge, Conqueror, King, Bridegroom
