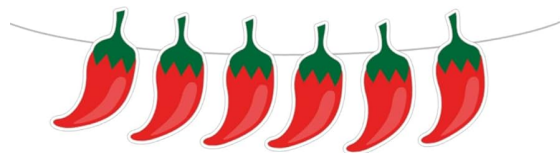
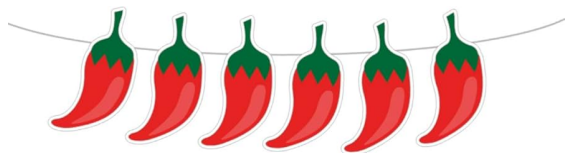


DUNSMORE CHILI COOK-OFF RULES

Our Calvary Chapel Santee Chili Master, Gary Dunsmore, is scaling back from making his Sunday morning chili. To thank him for his many years of delicious chili, we will be holding a chili cook-off in his honor. Bring your best chili to impress Gary along with the other judges!

- Each person must sign up by May 24th to be eligible to compete. The sign up sheet is available on the credenza in the Lobby.
- All chili cook off participants will bring their chili to the large grass in the back and place on the assigned table. Make sure your chili is in a crock-pot, warm, and ready-to-go.
- You will receive an entry number and description card. Please describe your chili, any outstanding features, and how hot it is. This will help the judges and attendees know just what to expect when they sample your chili's awesomeness!
- At least one person must be present during the chili cook-off. Someone must be representing the chili during the competition and tasting at all times. Guests are able to taste your chili entry until you run out. Please plan to prepare a large crockpot (6-8 quarts / 1.5-2 gallons) of chili to supply tasters for that time period.
- CCSantee will supply power, tables, chairs, tasting cups, spoons, and napkins for attendees.
- Please bring your own extension cords, ladles, spoon rests, potholders, and other items you think you will need.
- A selected panel of judges and special guest judge, Gary Dunsmore, will determine the Winner!



COMPETITION RULES

Round One is a Taste test ONLY!

Get your blank ballot and a pen ready.

Fill a tasting cup with just enough chili to taste.

Taste it, judge it, score it.

Repeat the process for ALL chili entries.

You must taste test ALL chili entries to vote!

Fill out your ballot and cast your vote.

Round Two Dig In and ENJOY!

Votes will be counted.

In case of a tie(s) a tie breaker will be held.

Re-casted votes will be counted.

Awards Ceremony will commence.
