Mark 15:37-41

The Group of Women

- Followers From Galilee
- Last at the Cross, First at the Empty Tomb
- V47 They Know Where the Tomb is

The Shock of Death

- Never Ready, Not Designed For It
- 1 Thess 4:13 Our Grief is Different

Mark 15:42-47

Preparation Day

- Friday, Sabbath at Sundown
- Jn 19:31 High Day, Sabbath and Passover
- Hurry ! 3pm- 6pm

Joseph & Nicodemus Claim the Body of Jesus Jn 19:36

- Pilate, The Centurion and Broken Bones Psa 34:20
- Roman Burial: Valley of Hinnom Psa 16:10

Nicodemus Jn 3:1-21 Must be Born Again!

Joseph Arimathea

- Moved to Jerusalem, To Live and Die There v43

Mark 15:40-47 “The Men Who Buried Jesus”

- Buys a Plot and Chisels A Brand New Tomb

Both are Sanhedrin Council Members

- Secret Disciples, Lk 23:51
- Step Out of the Shadows Isa 53:9

1. Genuine Faith Always Comes to the Surface

- God’s Love Presses
- Some Bridges Need to be Burned

Mk 15:46

They Took Him Down from the Cross

- A Messy Lifeless Body
- Jewish Burial: Washing, Linen, Spices, Tied, Head Wrap

Joseph’s New Tomb

2. Jesus is Buried in Expensive Tomb

- Rich and Poor 1 Tim 6:10 “The love of money”
- He Did What Other’s Could Not
